- Apply Azalea, Camellia & Rhododendron Food to Fertilize for More Blooms or Apply Azalea Evergreen Food Plus Systemic to Fertilize & Protect from Black Vine Weevil
- Remove winter mulch to warm up ground
- Shear back groundcovers
- Wake up flower beds with general fertilizer
- Prune roses when forsythia in bloom in your neighborhood cut back to 1/3 height, & Fertilize with Rose Food or Rose Food Plus Systemic to also protect from Insect & Disease
- Divide Perennials: Except Dicentra, Pulmanaria,
- Plant Conifers, Trees, & Shrubs
- Plant More Cool Season Crops Outside: Parsley, Argula, Broccoli, Cabbage, Carrot, Leek, Lettuce, Chard, Cauliflower & Turnip
- Start Pumpkin & Melon Seeds Inside
- Don't Let the Warmer Daytime Temps fool you & Keep Waiting to Plant Frost Sensitive Plants, it is still Frosting until May
