- Buy a Living Christmas Tree that you can plant in the garden later. While the tree is indoors keep its roots cool and moist by covering the soil with two trays of ice cubes daily.
- Prune evergreen conifers and use the branches in wreaths, swags and to display in pots. Be sure to cut just above side branches that you want to grow and don't leave stubs.
- Mulch - it's not too late to apply a 3 to 4 inch layer over beds of perennials, bulbs and shrubs
- Protect young trees from winter sunscald on their trunks by wrapping them with tree wrap
- Water - when temperatures stay above freezing, water dry spots in the garden, especially plants in containers and under house eaves
